WHAT IS BAPTISM?

Baptism is a public declaration of faith in Jesus Christ. It does not save us, but is an act of obedience that follows salvation. Through baptism, we identify with Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection and publicly declare that we belong to Him. (Romans 6:3-4; Matthew 28:19)



WHY BE BAPTIZED?

- Jesus commanded it. (Matthew 28:19)
- Jesus modeled it. (Matthew 3:13-17)
- The early church practiced it. (Acts 2:41)



WHO SHOULD BE BAPTIZED?

Anyone who has repented of sin and placed their faith in Jesus Christ should be baptized. (Acts 2:38-41)



DOES BAPTISM SAVE ME?

Baptism does not save us. We are saved by God's grace through faith in Jesus Christ. Baptism is the outward expression of an inward transformation. (Ephesians 2:8-9)
